Programs

Rotary Foundation: The Rotary Foundation helps Rotary members advance world understanding, goodwill, and peace by improving health, providing quality education, improving the environment, and alleviating poverty.

Junior Achievement: The world's largest organization dedicated to educating students in grades K-12 about entrepreneurship, work readiness and financial literacy through hands-on programs within Napa Valley schools. The program is free for all students, and members within the Napa Sunrise Rotary Club volunteer their time to teach the Junior Achievement program.

Napa 4th of July Parade: The Napa 4th of July Parade is a free family friendly event, showcasing our patriotic spirit, community organizations, and cross cultural talent.

Napa School Dictionary Drive: The program provides free dictionaries to students within the Napa Valley. Nationally, the dictionary project has provided more than 31 million students with a dictionary to promote literacy and enhance education.

Agape Food Distribution: The Agape Emergency Food Program serves Napa Valley by providing nutritious food and necessities to everyone without judgement or questions. Funds are used to purchase items for local people who are struggling with food hardship. Members within the Napa Sunrise Rotary Club donate their time to help with this program.

Rise Against Hunger: A growing global movement to end hunger by empowering communities, nourishing lives, and responding to emergencies. This international humanitarian effort has a goal to deliver 1.5 billion meals by 2025.

Operation With Love From Home: A local non-partisan project to support service men and women by providing care packages three times a year. The packages serve as a vital link to remind troops they are valued and loved.

Abode Service Shelter: Operates the South Napa Shelter and the South Napa Day Center. Efforts include operating an emergency shelter and providing outreach, housing support, and rental assistance.

Boys & Girls Club – Summer Camp: Providing full-service summer camp experiences in Napa and American Canyon. The program provides a safe environment for local children to gain the knowledge and skills needed in life.



Shelter Box: Portable shelters delivered to areas hit by disasters leaving families without homes. Shelter kits provide temporary housing, tools and materials needed to start rebuilding homes.

Rotary Youth Leadership Awards: A program coordinated by Rotary Clubs around the globe for participants to develop skills as a leader while having fun and making connections.

High School Scholarships: Recognizing students who have been identified by educators and school administrators in Napa as high performing engaged community leaders who have overcome obstacles and continue to thrive.

Walk for Alzheimer: The Napa Valley Alzheimer Walk, hosted in Yountville, provides awareness and resources for the local community in addition to raising funds for care and support.
